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THE FOUNDATION: JESUS CHRIST THE SON OF GOD

Prophecies of Messiah

- 1. The Messiah would be the seed/offspring of a woman and would crush the head of Satan (Genesis 3:15).
- Jesus was born of Mary and crucified on a hill called the place of a skull (Matthew 1:16-18; John 19:16-18).
- 2. He would come from the seed/offspring of Abraham and would bless all the nations on earth (Genesis 12:3).
- Jesus was a descendent of Abraham (Matthew 1:1).
- He would be a "prophet like Moses" to whom God said we must listen (Deuteronomy 18:15).
- Jesus was considered a prophet (Matthew 14:5).
- 4. He would be born in Bethlehem of Judah (Micah 5:2).
- Jesus was born in Bethlehem (Matthew 2:1).
- 5. He would be born of a virgin (Isaiah 7:14).
- Jesus was born of a virgin (Matthew 1:18-25).
- He would have a throne, a kingdom and a dynasty, or house, starting with King David, that will last forever (2 Samuel 7:16).
- Jesus established an everlasting kingdom (2 Peter 1:11).
- He would be called "Wonderful Counselor," "Mighty God," "Everlasting Father," "Prince of Peace," and would possess an everlasting kingdom (Isaiah 9:6-7).
- Jesus said that "I and my Father are one." (John 10:30).
- He would ride into Jerusalem on a donkey, righteous and having salvation, coming with gentleness (Zechariah 9:9-10).
- Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey (Matthew 21:1-8).
- He would be pierced for our transgression and crushed for our iniquities (Isaiah 53:5).
- A soldier pierced Jesus' side while He hung upon the cross (John 19:34).
- 10. He would die among the wicked ones but be buried with the rich (Isaiah 53:9).
- Jesus died among two thieves but was buried with the rich (Matthew 27:38; 27:57-60).
- 11. He would be resurrected from the grave, for God would not allow His Holy One to suffer decay (Psalm 16:10).
- Jesus was resurrected and others came out of their graves too (Matthew 27:52-53; John 20:24-28).
- 12. He would come again from the clouds of heaven as the Son of Man (Daniel 7:13-14).
- Jesus told the high priest that He was Messiah and that He would come in the clouds of heaven (Mark 14:61-62; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17).

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Jesus Christ is God

The Word Became Flesh

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

I and my Father are one > John 10:30 I and my Father are one.

John 10:31 Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him.

John 10:33 The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and **because** that **thou, being a man, makest thyself God**.

Jesus and Thomas

John 20:24 But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came.

John 20:25 The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe.

John 20:26 And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you.

John 20:27 Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing. John 20:28 And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God.

The Witnesses of John, Thomas and Jesus Christ Himself

Matthew 18:16 But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that <u>in</u> the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.

The Personality of God and Christ

<u>Matthew 11:27</u> All things are delivered unto me of my **Father**: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and he to whomsoever **the Son will reveal him**.

<u>Isaiah 40:28</u> Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, that **the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth**, fainteth not, neither is weary? there is no searching of his understanding.

<u>Hebrews 1:1-3</u> God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his **Son**, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, **by whom also he made the worlds**; Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

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Psalm 95:3 For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods.

<u>Revelation 17:12</u> And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast.

Revelation 17:13 These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast.

Revelation 17:14 These shall make war with the Lamb, and **the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings**: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful.

Revelation 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called **Faithful and True**, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. Revelation 19:12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and **on his head were many crowns**; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

Revelation 19:13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

<u>Isaiah 28:26</u> For his **God doth instruct him** to discretion, and **doth teach him**.

<u>John 13:13-14</u> <u>Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am. If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

Master: *didaskalos* = teacher</u>

<u>Deuteronomy 8:5</u> Thou shalt also consider in thine heart, that, **as a man chasteneth his** son, so the LORD thy God chasteneth thee.

<u>Revelation 3:19</u> As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.

<u>Lamentations 3:32-33</u> But though he cause grief, yet will he have compassion according to the multitude of his mercies. For **he doth not afflict willingly** nor grieve the children of men.

Exodus 34:6-7 And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children, unto the third and to the fourth generation.

<u>Psalm 11:5</u> The LORD trieth the righteous: but the wicked and him that loveth violence his soul hateth.

<u>Proverbs 8:13</u> The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and **the froward mouth, do I hate**.

<u>Psalm 11:7</u> For **the righteous LORD loveth righteousness**; his countenance doth behold the upright.

Romans 5:6 For when we were yet without strength, in due time **Christ died for the ungodly**.

Romans 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

<u>2 Peter 3:9</u> The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

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THE FIRST ANGEL'S MESSAGE

The Everlasting Gospel

EVERLASTING

Greek: aionios

Definition: from the beginning or since the world began

GOSPEL

Greek: euagellion

Definition: good message or good news

<u>Genesis 3:14-15</u> And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life: And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

John 19:16-18 Then delivered he him therefore unto them to be crucified. And they took Jesus, and led him away. And he bearing his cross went forth into a place called the place of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha: Where they crucified him, and two other with him, on either side one, and Jesus in the midst.

<u>Romans 16:20</u> And **the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly**. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.

<u>Hebrews 4:14-16</u> Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

<u>John 1:12</u> But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of **God**, even to them that believe on his name:

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me. <u>Luke 10:19</u> Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

<u>Leviticus 16:7-8</u> And he shall take the two goats, and present them before the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. And Aaron shall cast lots upon the two goats; one lot for the LORD, and the other lot for the scapegoat.

<u>Leviticus 16:9-10</u> And Aaron shall bring the goat upon which the LORD'S lot fell, and offer him for a sin offering. But the goat, on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat, shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make an atonement with him, and to let him go for a scapegoat into the wilderness.

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<u>Leviticus 16:20-23</u> And when he hath made an end of reconciling the holy place, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar, **he shall bring the live goat:** And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness: And the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness. And Aaron shall come into the tabernacle of the congregation, and shall put off the linen garments, which he put on when he went into the holy place, and shall leave them there:

Revelation 20:1-3 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

Revelation 16:17-20 And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done. And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great. And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath. And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.

<u>Isaiah 24:1,3,19</u> Behold, the Lord maketh the earth empty, and maketh it waste. ... The land shall be utterly emptied, and utterly spoiled: for the Lord hath spoken this word. ... The earth is utterly broken down, the earth is clean dissolved, the earth is moved exceedingly

Revelation 20:7-10 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea. And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them. And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

<u>2 Corinthians 2:12</u> Furthermore, when I came to Troas to preach **Christ's gospel**, and a door was opened unto me of the Lord,

Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of **the gospel of Christ**: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Romans 15:19 Through mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have fully preached **the gospel of**

Christ.

- Rev. 13:8: 17:8. Wicked are not recorded. G.C. 483.
- Rev. 20:15. None will be saved whose names are not recorded in the book of life. Isa. 4:3, margin; Ps. 69:28; Heb. 12:23; Dan. 12:1.

WARNINGS

<u>Numbers 32:23</u> But if ye will not do so, behold, ye have sinned against the LORD: and **be** sure your sin will find you out.

WHAT WAS NAILED TO THE CROSS?

<u>Colossians 2:13-14</u> And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; **Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us**, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, **nailing it to his cross**;

Jeremiah 31:35-36 Thus saith the LORD, which giveth the sun for a light by day, and the ordinances of the moon and of the stars for a light by night, which divideth the sea when the waves thereof roar; The LORD of hosts is his name: If those ordinances depart from before me, saith the LORD, then the seed of Israel also shall cease from being a nation before me for ever.

<u>Hebrews 10:1</u> For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.

<u>John 1:29</u> The next day John seeth **Jesus** coming unto him, and saith, Behold **the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.**

<u>Matthew 27:50-51</u> Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost. And, behold, **the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom**; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;

→ This signified that the earthly sanctuary services had fulfilled their purpose and that all types had been fulfilled in Christ.

- 7. Contrary to us, against us (Colossians 2:14)
- 8. Judges no one (Colossians 2:14-16)
- 9. Carnal (Hebrews 7:16)
- 10. Made nothing perfect (Hebrews 7:19)

- 2. Called the royal law (James 2:8)
- Written by God on stone (Exodus 31:18; 32:16)
- 4. Placed inside the ark (Exodus 40:20)
- 5. Will stand forever (Luke 16:17)
- 6. Points out sin (Romans 7:7; 3:20)
- 7. Not grievous (1 John 5:3)
- 8. Judges all people (James 2:10-12)
- 9. Spiritual (Romans 7:14)
- 10. Perfect (Psalm 19:7)

GOD'S LAW IN THE OLD AND NEW TESTAMENTS

Exodus 20:3

Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

Matthew 4:10

Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

Exodus 20:4-5

Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them...

Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.

For a smuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device.

For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

Romans 7:7

What shall we say then? Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.

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Natural Law

<u>Isaiah 42:21</u> The LORD is well pleased for his righteousness' sake; **he will magnify the law**, and make it honourable.

<u>Matthew 5:17</u> Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

Jesus came to magnify the law and make it honourable. He filled full the law. He
was the Great Exemplar. A perfect offering without any blemish of sin and
disease.

<u>Deuteronomy 6:2 - 3</u> That thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to **keep all his statutes and his commandments**, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and **that thy days may be prolonged**. Hear therefore, O Israel, and observe to do it; that it may be well with thee, and **that ye may increase mightily**, as the LORD God of thy fathers hath promised thee, in the land that floweth with milk and honey.

Exodus 20:13 Thou shalt not kill.

<u>Psalm 119:96</u> I have seen an end of all perfection: but **thy commandment is exceeding broad.**

<u>Matthew 5:21-22</u> Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment: But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.

<u>Psalm 37:8</u> Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not thyself in any wise to do evil.

 Ungodly anger and hatred can bring with them anxiety and depression. A poor state of mental health

Exodus 20:14 Thou shalt not commit adultery.

<u>Psalm 119:96</u> I have seen an end of all perfection: but **thy commandment is exceeding broad.**

<u>Matthew 5:27-28</u> Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery: But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

<u>1 Corinthians 6:18</u> Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but **he** that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.

Hope, Health & Wholeness for All

<u>Psalms 51:1,8</u> To the chief Musician, A **Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba.** Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions. **Make me to hear joy and gladness; that the bones which thou hast broken may rejoice**.

<u>2 Samuel 11:2-5</u> And it came to pass in an eveningtide, that David arose from off his bed, and walked upon the roof of the king's house: and from the roof he saw a woman washing herself; and the woman was very beautiful to look upon. And David sent and enquired after the woman. And one said, Is not this Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam, the wife of Uriah the Hittite? And **David sent messengers, and took her; and she came in unto him, and he lay with her**; for she was purified from her uncleanness: and she returned unto her house. And **the woman conceived, and sent and told David, and said, I am with child.**

<u>2 Samuel 11:15-17</u> And he wrote in the letter, saying, Set ye Uriah in the forefront of the hottest battle, and retire ye from him, that he may be smitten, and die. And it came to pass, when Joab observed the city, that he assigned Uriah unto a place where he knew that valiant men were. And the men of the city went out, and fought with Joab: and there fell some of the people of the servants of David; and **Uriah the Hittite died** also.

<u>2 Samuel 12:15</u> And Nathan departed unto his house. And the LORD struck the child that Uriah's wife bare unto David, and **it was very sick**.

Genesis 25:30-34 And Esau said to Jacob, Feed me, I pray thee, with that same red pottage; for I am faint: therefore was his name called Edom. And Jacob said, Sell me this day thy birthright. And Esau said, Behold, I am at the point to die: and what profit shall this birthright do to me? And Jacob said, Swear to me this day; and he sware unto him: and he sold his birthright unto Jacob. Then Jacob gave Esau bread and pottage of lentiles; and he did eat and drink, and rose up, and went his way: thus Esau despised his birthright.

<u>Hebrews 12:16-17</u> Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright. For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears.

When Did Judgment Begin?

Daniel 7:9-10 I beheld till the **thrones were cast down**, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire. A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: **the judgment was set, and the books were opened**.

Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

Daniel 8:14 And he said unto me, <u>Unto two thousand and three hundred days</u>; then shall the sanctuary be cleansed.

Hebrews 8:1-2 Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens; A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, and not man.

Hebrews 9:24-25 For **Christ** is not **entered** into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but **into heaven itself**, **now to appear in the presence of God for us**: Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest **entereth into the holy place** every year with blood of others;

Daniel 9:24 Seventy weeks are determined (cut off) upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

Daniel 9:25 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

- \rightarrow Day = year (Num 14:34, Eze 4:6) SEVENTY WEEKS = 70w x 7d = 490 d/y
- → When does the 490 year prophetic time period begin? It begins from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem.
- → Ezra 7:12-13 Artaxerxes, king of kings, unto Ezra the priest, a scribe of the law of the God of heaven, perfect peace, and at such a time. I make a decree, that all they of the people of Israel, and of his priests and Levites, in my realm, which are minded of their own freewill to go up to Jerusalem, go with thee
- → Ezra 7:7-9 And there went up some of the children of Israel, and of the priests, and the Levites, and the singers, and the porters, and the Nethinims, unto Jerusalem, in the seventh year of Artaxerxes the king. And he came to Jerusalem in the fifth month, which was in the seventh year of the king. For upon the first day of the first month began he to go up from Babylon, and on the first day of the fifth month came he to Jerusalem, according to the good hand of his God upon him.
- → THE AUTUMN OF 457 BC WAS WHEN THE COMMAND WAS GIVEN

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- → Since we are calculating time from BC to AD, we have to subtract.
- → 2300 YRS 457 YRS= 1843 YRS
- → This does not account for year zero in our modern calculation of time. Since there is no such thing as a literal year zero, we add one year.
- → 1843 YRS + 1 YR = 1844 AD Autumn

Daniel 9:26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

- → 1) Seven weeks which begin from the decree to rebuild Jerusalem
- → 7 weeks x 7 days = 49 days (years)
- → 457 BC 49 years = 408 BC (When Jerusalem was restored)
- → 2) In threescore and two weeks Messiah is killed
- → Threescore (60) and Two (2)
- → 62 weeks x 7 days = 434 days (years)
- → 408BC 434 years =AD 26
- → There is no year zero. Add 1. AD 27
- → AD 27 autumn was the time of Christ's baptism AND the beginning of His ministry of healing
- → Luke 3:21-22 Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that Jesus also being baptized, and praying, the heaven was opened, And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.
- → Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.
 - To this time Jesus referred when He declared, "The time is fulfilled" (Mark 1:15; DA 233). Jesus was anointed at the time of His baptism in the autumn of A.D. 27 (see also Luke 4:18).

Daniel 9:27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for **one week**: and **in the midst of the week** he **shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease**, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

- → In the middle of one prophetic week, the earthly sanctuary services would be made void.
- → 1 week = 7 years
- One half of a prophetic week is 3.5 years
- → This 3.5 year period starts at the beginning of Christ's ministry which was in AD 27
- → AD 27 + 3.5 years = 30.5 (round up 31 AD)
- → Christ was crucified in the spring of AD 31

How did Christ's ministry to the Jewish nation continue for another 3.5 years after His death?

Hebrews 13:5-6 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for **he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper,** and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.

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Christ worked through His followers to continue ministering to the Jews.

AD 30.5 + 3.5 years = AD 34

What happened in AD 34?

Acts 7:59-60 And **they stoned Stephen**, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit. And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, he fell asleep.

Stephen was murdered by the Jews in the autumn of AD 34

The "vineyard" was then "let out unto other husbandmen" (Matt. 21:41; cf. Isa. 5:1–7; GC 328, 410).

Remember the remaining 1810 years that we calculated earlier? We now have two remaining chunks of time.

1810 + 34 = AD 1844 Autumn

2 ways of calculating the time

- 1) 2300 years 457 years
 - = AD 1844 Autumn (+1 for yr 0)
- 2) 1810 years + 34 = AD 1844 Autumn

<u>Leviticus 23:27</u> Also on the tenth day of this seventh month there shall be a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

Interpretation

The day of atonement, the tenth day of the seventh month, fell in 1844 on October 22, at which time the 2,300 days ended.

What Is Happening During the Judgment?

<u>Daniel 8:14</u> And he said unto me, Unto two thousand and three hundred days; then shall the **sanctuary** be cleansed.

Fear God

<u>Malachi 1:6</u> A son honoureth his father, and a servant his master: if then I be a father, where is mine honour? and if I be a master, where is my fear? saith the LORD of hosts unto you, O priests, that despise my name. And ye say, Wherein have we despised thy name?

- God is to be feared, worshipped and given sacrifices (2King 17:36)
- We are to give God our lives in service to Him (Rom 12:1)
- The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise. (Psa 51:17)
- By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. (Heb 13:15)
- Doing good and communicating your faith are good sacrifices (Heb 13:16)
- The fear of God involves refraining from bad language and lying. It also involves doing good and departing from evil. The fear of God motivates people to seek peace. (Psa 34:11-14)
- While we walk in the fear of the Lord, we receive the comfort of the Holy Spirit (Act 9:31)
- We learn to fear God by hearing His words and we should teach our children the fear of the Lord (Deut 4:10)
- We learn to fear the Lord by reading/studying our Bibles (Deut 17:18,19)

We should fear God because:

- God is watchful over the righteous and listens to them (Psa 34:15)
- God is against people who do evil (Psa 34:16)
- The Lord kills and makes alive. He humbles and exalts people (1Sam 2:6,7)
- The fear of the Lord tends to life (Prov 19:23) Prolongs life (Prov 10:27)
- The fear of the Lord and humility brings riches, honour and life (Prov 22:4)
- He will bless them that fear the LORD, both small and great. (Psa 115:13)
- Those who fear the Lord are happy (Prov 28:14)

WORSHIP HIM: The Sabbath

Genesis 2:1 Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them.

Genesis 2:2 And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.

Genesis 2:3 And **God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it**: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

• Before there was any Jew, the Sabbath was instituted at creation for mankind.

<u>Ephesians 3:8-9</u> Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ; And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in **God, who created all things by Jesus Christ**:

<u>Hebrews 1:1-2</u> God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hath in these last days spoken unto us by **his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds**;

Jesus is God and He created the world and instituted the Sabbath.

Matthew 12:8 For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.

<u>Exodus 20:10</u> But **the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God**: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates:

<u>Exodus 20:11</u> For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore **the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it**.

The Son of man, who is Jesus Christ, is Lord of the Sabbath day.

<u>Malachi 3:6</u> For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

Mark 2:27-28 And he said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath: Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.

Jesus would not change His special day of worship. He is the same all the time.

Mark 6:1 -2 And he went out from thence, and came into his own country; and his disciples follow him. And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing him were astonished, saying, From whence hath this man these things? and what wisdom is this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands?

Luke 4:16 And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

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• Jesus led by example. He kept the Sabbath during His life on Earth.

Mark 16:1-2 And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him. And very early in the morning the first day of the week, they came unto the sepulchre at the rising of the sun.

<u>Luke 23:54-56</u> And that day was the preparation, and the sabbath drew on. And **the women** also, which came with him from Galilee, followed after, and beheld the sepulchre, and how his body was laid. And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and **rested the sabbath day according to the commandment**.

• The female followers of Christ kept the seventh day Sabbath.

Acts 13:13 Now when **Paul and his company** loosed from Paphos, they came to Perga in Pamphylia: and John departing from them returned to Jerusalem.

Acts 13:14 But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in Pisidia, and went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and sat down.

Acts 13:15 And after the reading of the law and the prophets the rulers of the synagogue sent unto them, saying, Ye men and brethren, if ye have any word of exhortation for the people, say on.

Acts 13:42 And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be preached to them the next sabbath.

Acts 13:43 Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the grace of God.

Acts 13:44 And the next sabbath day came almost the whole city together to hear the word of God.

Acts 16:11 Therefore loosing from Troas, we came with a straight course to Samothracia, and the next day to Neapolis;

Acts 16:12 And from thence to Philippi, which is the chief city of that part of Macedonia, and a colony: and we were in that city abiding certain days.

Acts 16:13 And on the sabbath we went out of the city by a river side, where prayer was wont to be made; and we sat down, and spake unto the women which resorted thither.

Acts 17:1 Now when they had passed through Amphipolis and Apollonia, they came to Thessalonica, where was a synagogue of the Jews:

Acts 17:2 And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three sabbath days reasoned with them out of the scriptures,

Acts 17:3 Opening and alleging, that Christ must needs have suffered, and risen again from the dead; and that this Jesus, whom I preach unto you, is Christ.

Acts 17:4 And some of them believed, and consorted with Paul and Silas; and of the devout Greeks a great multitude, and of the chief women not a few.

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Acts 18:1 After these things Paul departed from Athens, and came to Corinth;

Acts 18:2 And found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla; (because that Claudius had commanded all Jews to depart from Rome:) and came unto them.

Acts 18:3 And because he was of the same craft, he abode with them, and wrought: for by their occupation they were tentmakers.

Acts 18:4 And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks.

• Paul and the apostles all kept the seventh day Sabbath.

Leviticus 23:32 It shall be unto you a sabbath of rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth day of the month at even, from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath.

Mark 1:32 And at even, when the sun did set, they brought unto him all that were diseased, and them that were possessed with devils.

Mark 15:42 And now when the even was come, because it was the preparation, that is, the day before the sabbath,

Exodus 20:8 Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

Exodus 20:9 Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work:

Exodus 20:10 But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates:

Nehemiah 13:15 In those days saw I in Judah some treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all manner of burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I testified against them in the day wherein they sold victuals.

Nehemiah 13:16 There dwelt men of Tyre also therein, which brought fish, and all manner of ware, and sold on the sabbath unto the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.

Nehemiah 13:17 Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said unto them, What evil thing is this that ye do, and **profane the sabbath day**?

Nehemiah 13:18 Did not your fathers thus, and did not our God bring all this evil upon us, and upon this city? yet ye bring more wrath upon Israel by profaning the sabbath.

Nehemiah 13:19 And it came to pass, that when the gates of Jerusalem began to be dark before the sabbath, I commanded that the gates should be shut, and charged that they should not be opened till after the sabbath: and some of my servants set I at the gates, that there should **no burden be brought in on the sabbath day**.

Nehemiah 13:20 So the merchants and sellers of all kind of ware lodged without Jerusalem once or twice.

Nehemiah 13:21 Then I testified against them, and said unto them, Why lodge ye about the wall? if ye do so again, I will lay hands on you. From that time forth came they no more on the sabbath.

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Nehemiah 13:22 And I commanded the Levites that they should cleanse themselves, and that they should come and keep the gates, to **sanctify the sabbath day**. Remember me, O my God, concerning this also, and spare me according to the greatness of thy mercy.

Exodus 35:3 Ye shall kindle no fire throughout your habitations upon the sabbath day.

Exodus 16:22 And it came to pass, that on the sixth day they gathered twice as much bread, two omers for one man: and all the rulers of the congregation came and told Moses.

Exodus 16:23 And he said unto them, This is that which the LORD hath said, **To morrow is** the rest of the holy sabbath unto the LORD: bake that which ye will bake to day, and seethe that ye will seethe; and that which remaineth over lay up for you to be kept until the morning.

Exodus 16:24 And they laid it up till the morning, as Moses bade: and it did not stink, neither was there any worm therein.

Exodus 16:25 And Moses said, Eat that to day; for to day is a sabbath unto the LORD: to day ye shall not find it in the field.

Exodus 16:26 Six days ye shall gather it; but on the seventh day, which is the sabbath, in it there shall be none.

 The following activities should be done preparatory to the Sabbath: buying and selling, cooking, washing and bathing.

Isaiah 58:13 If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words:

On Sabbath, we are not to do what we want to do. We are supposed to delight
in holy activities and holy conversation on Sabbath. We should go to church,
preach, teach, study the Bible, do missionary work, heal and rest on the Lord's
day.

Mark 3:1 And he entered again into the synagogue; and there was a man there which had a withered hand.

Mark 3:2 And they watched him, whether he would **heal him on the sabbath day**; that they might accuse him.

Mark 3:3 And he saith unto the man which had the withered hand, Stand forth.

Mark 3:4 And he saith unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace.

Mark 3:5 And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, **Stretch forth thine hand**. And he stretched it out: and **his hand was restored whole as the other**.

• It is lawful to take care of people and heal them on the Sabbath.

THE SECOND ANGEL'S MESSAGE

Babylon the Confused

BABEL - means confusion

There are over 4,000 recognized religions in the world. These religions consist of churches, congregations, faith groups, tribes, cultures, and movements. With over 4000 religions being taught everywhere, surely the world is in a state of confusion as to know how to be saved. All 4000 plus religions can't all be right.

Babylon the Gate of the Gods

In Babylonian the name *Bab–ilu* (Babel, or Babylon) meant "gate of the gods," but the Hebrews called the city *balal*, a word in their language meaning "to confuse" (Gen. 11:9).

- The rulers of Babylon doubtless called their city the "gate" of the gods.
- They chose to think of it as the place where the gods worked with people, to guide the kingdom and control the earth (see on Judges 9:35; Ruth 4:1; 1 Kings 22:10; Jer. 22:3).
- Babylonian kings felt that they had been given control of the world by divine power
- The prophet Isaiah identifies Lucifer as the invisible king of Babylon (see on Isa.14:4, 12–14).
- Satan designed to make Babylon the center and agency of his master plan to secure control of the human race, even as God purposed to work through Jerusalem. Thus, throughout OT times, the two cities typified the forces of evil and good at work in the world.

Babylon has been recognized as the traditional enemy of God's truth and people. As used in the Revelation the name is symbolic of all apostate religious organizations and their leadership, from antiquity down to the close of time.

John uses the name "Babylon" to describe all religious bodies and movements that have fallen away from the truth. This fact requires us to view this "fall" as progressive and cumulative. This is evident by the repetition of "is fallen".

Babylon the Mother of Harlots

Revelation 17:1 And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many waters:

The great whore is a woman.

- Woman represents a church → Jeremiah 6:2, Isaiah 51:16, Ephesians 5:23
- This church is described as a prostitute. This means that she is an unfaithful woman.

She sits upon many waters.

- Revelation 17:15 → waters represent all the nations and people of the world

Revelation 17:2 With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.

The people of the world are drunk from her wine.

- Wine represents teachings → Ecclesiastes 2:3, Isaiah 28:7
- Because the people are made drunk by the wine, this means that the wine has alcohol in it.

Proverbs 20:1 Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is **deceived thereby** is not wise.

The unfaithful church is present in every nation and teaches false doctrines which deceive the world.

Revelation 17:3 So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.

- Revelation 17:9 says that the seven heads are seven mountains.
 - Rome is a city that sits on top 7 mountains. So we now know that the false church is located in Rome.
- "full of names of blasphemy" → What is blasphemy?
 - Matthew 26:63-65 → claiming to be God is blasphemy
 - John 10:33 The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, makest thyself God.
- There is only one church in Rome that has blasphemed God.
 - The Gloss of Extravagantes of Pope John XXII says this: But to believe that our Lord God the Pope the establisher of said decretal, and of this, could not decree, as he did decree, should be accounted heretical (emphasis added).

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140 (Paris, 1685). In an Antwerp edition of the Extravagantes, the words, Dominum Deum Nostrum Papam ("Our Lord God the Pope") can be found in column 153.

The pope of the Roman Catholic Church has the title
 VICARIUS FILII DEI. THE LITERAL MEANING: VICARIUS substituting for, or in place of. FILII - means son. DEI – means
 God. The pope says he takes the place of the Son of God. He says
 he is Jesus Christ.

Revelation 17:5 And upon her forehead *was* a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

The Roman Catholic Church is the mother of all the other unfaithful churches.
 She gave birth to hundreds of churches. This great birth happened through the Protestant Reformation. Initially the Protestant Reformation was good, but the churches continued to hold onto some Roman Catholic doctrines.

Revelation 17:6 And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration.

Revelation 1:5- Figuratively speaking, Jesus' blood washes away our sins.

Red or scarlet can represent forgiveness of sins. The Roman Catholic clergymen are called fathers, and Roman Catholics are supposed to confess their sins to them and be forgiven.

Hope, Health & Wholeness for All

GOLD, PRECIOUS STONES AND PEARLS

The Roman Catholic Church is incredibly wealthy.

PRECIOUS STONES

Proverbs 20:15-knowledge

The precious stones represent knowledge, but not heavenly knowledge. Because these precious stones belong to the apostate church, they would represent satanic wisdom which really is not wisdom at all.

PEARLS

Revelation 17:4, 18:12-16, Matthew 13:45- Pearls can represent anything very precious.

Matthew 7:6- In this place pearls represent the doctrines of the Bible.

The papacy is adorned with many counterfeit and corrupt doctrines that they parade around as something precious. Their teachings about indulgences is a good example.

CUP

The Roman Catholic Church offers a counterfeit salvation. According to their religion, you work your way to holiness or buy your way to heaven by purchasing indulgences.

Jeremiah 16:7 - Cup can represent consolation

The Roman Catholic Church offers a false sense of comfort for sinners. Those who are works oriented can save themselves through their good merits. Those who are very wicked can confess their sins to a man and pay money to spend less time in purgatory.

Psalms 23:5- Cup can represent joy.

The Roman Catholic leaders are the most wicked and greatest hypocrites ever known. They make bold pretensions to piety and holiness; yet, inwardly they are ravening wolves. In Job 20:5 the Bible says that the triumphing of the wicked is short, and the joy of the hypocrite but for a moment...The true priests and ministers of the Lord have joy everlasting (Isaiah 61:6, 7)

Isaiah 51:17, 22; **Jeremiah 25:15**— Cup can represent an outpouring of the Lord's anger which makes people to tremble and shake in fear.

Immediately after death the souls of those who die in a state of mortal sin descend into hell, where they suffer the punishments of hell, "eternal fire." The chief punishment of hell is eternal separation from God, in whom alone man can possess the life and happiness for which he was created and for which he longs. (CCC 1035)

Advocating and exalting the first day of the week above God's holy, sanctified day

1) THE ROMAN CATHOLIC TEACHING:

i. <u>Cardinal James Gibbons, The Faith of Our Fathers (Ayers</u> Publishing, 1978): 108:

But you may read the Bible from Genesis to Revelation, and you will not find a single line authorizing the sanctification of Sunday. The Scriptures enforce the religious observance of Saturday, a day which we never sanctify.

ii. The Convert's Catechism of Catholic Doctrine (1957): 50:

Q. Which is the Sabbath day?

A. Saturday is the Sabbath day.

Q. Why Do we observe Sunday instead of Saturday?

A. We observe Sunday instead of Saturday because the Catholic Church transferred the solemnity from Saturday to Sunday.

iii. Chancellor Albert Smith for Cardinal of Baltimore Archdiocese, letter dated February 10, 1920:

If Protestants would follow the Bible, they should worship God on the Sabbath day by God is Saturday. In keeping the Sunday, they are following a law of the Catholic Church.

iv. <u>Stephen Keenan, Catholic—Doctrinal Catechism 3rd Edition:</u>174:

Question: Have you any other way of proving the Church has power to institute festivals of precept?

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Activities on the Lord's Day should be commensurate with the Christian's conscience under the Lordship of Jesus Christ."

ii. <u>Dr. E. T. Hiscox, author of the 'Baptist Manual'</u>
"There was and is a command to keep holy the Sabbath
day, but that Sabbath day was not Sunday. It will however
be readily said, and with some show of triumph, that the
Sabbath was transferred from the seventh to the first day
of the week, with all its duties, privileges and sanctions.
Earnestly desiring information on this subject, which I have
studied for many years, I ask, where can the record of such
a transaction be found: Not in the New Testament —
absolutely not. There is no scriptural evidence of the change
of the Sabbath institution from the seventh to the first day
of the week."

4) Lutheran

- "The observance of the Lord's Day (Sunday) is founded not on any command of God, but on the authority of the Church." Augsburg Confession of Faith.

Islam

2:39 "KEEP YOUR COVENANT AND I WILL BE TRUE TO MINE."

In this Quran passage, God's faithfulness is dependent upon the faithfulness of man to keep his side of the bargain. This is also unbiblical. Throughout the Old Testament, God is faithful to the promises He makes irregardless of man's unfaithfulness. 2:39 does not describe a covenant, but a contract. God's covenant are always kept by Him even if they are not kept by man. II Timothy 2:13 states, "If we are faithless, He remains faithful; for He cannot deny Himself."

2:236 "IT SHALL BE NO OFFENSE FOR YOU TO DIVORCE YOUR WIVES BEFORE THE MARRIAGE IS CONSUMMATED OR THE DOWRY IS SETTLED."

Wrong! Malachi 2:16, "I hate divorce." Joseph didn't feel that way about Mary when he "planned secretly to put her away," did he?

2:267 "...TO GIVE ALMS TO THE POOR IN PRIVATE IS BETTER AND WILL ATONE FOR SOME OF YOUR SINS."

The scripture records that only the blood of Jesus Christ can atone for our sins. Romans 5:11, And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.

3:29 "SAY, 'OBEY GOD AND THE APOSTLE.' IF THEY GIVE NO HEED, THEN TRULY, GOD DOES NOT LOVE THE UNBELIEVERS."

In the Quran, the love of God for a person is dependent upon whether or not a person obeys God. In the Bible, God loves both the believer and the unbeliever, the obedient and the rebellious. He rewards the obedient, and tries to draw the rebellious to Him.

God does not hate unbelievers: Luke 6:35 But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and to the evil.

3:178 "LET NOT THE UNBELIEVERS THINK THAT WE PROLONG THEIR DAYS FOR THEIR OWN GOOD, WE GIVE THEM RESPITE ONLY SO THAT THEY MAY COMMIT MORE GRIEVOUS SINS. SHAMEFUL PUNISHMENT AWAITS THEM." [GO TO CONTENT TABLE]

This passage suggest that God allows unbelievers to have long lives so that they might commit more sin that might be punished by God in a greater fashion. WRONG.

Romans 2:4 Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

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Hinduism

Hinduism refers to a whole family of religious traditions deeply rooted in the Indian subcontinent.

Mark 12:32 And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for **there** is **one God; and there** is **none other but he**:

1Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

Material and spiritual existence unfolds in a series of unimaginably long cycles governed by a cosmic Law called Dharma (from a root that means "to hold together"). That Law manifests itself on the level of individual beings as a potentially endless succession or cycle of birth and rebirth.

Ecclesiastes 12:7 Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it.

→ the breath of life goes back to God in Heaven, no cycle

2Peter 3:10-13 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat? Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

Nahum 1:9 What do ye imagine against the LORD? he will make an utter end: **affliction** shall not rise up the second time.

→ There is no endless cycle. An end is coming when there will be no death and no more sin.

IT'S A RELIGION

2 Kings 5:27 The leprosy therefore of Naaman shall cleave unto thee, and unto thy seed for ever. And he went out from his presence a leper as white as snow.

Did Gehazi remain a leper forever? No. He died.

1 Chronicles 28:4 David, in delivering his charge to Israel and to Solomon, declared: "Howbeit the Lord God of Israel chose me before all the house of my father to be king over Israel for ever."

David's death is recorded: "the days that David reigned over Israel were forty years." $^{\sim}$ 1 Kings 2:11

DOES EVERLASTING ALWAYS MEAN FOREVER AND BEYOND?

Peter, on the day of Pentecost, said: "Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulcher is with us unto this day. . . . For David is not ascended into the heavens." \sim Acts 2:29, 34

Paul remarks that David "fell on sleep, and was laid unto his fathers, and saw corruption." \sim Acts 13:36

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How long did God mean that David should reign when He said that this king would rule over Israel "for ever"? He meant that David should be king over that people as long as he should live. And it was so, for he reigned over them 40 years until he died.

FOREVER CAN MEAN A DEFINITE TIME PERIOD. A TIME PERIOD WHICH HAS AN END.

GREEK - Hades

- Comes from two Greek words
 - "a" meaning not and "idein" meaning to see
 - MEANING: not seen or unseen
- The realm of the dead or where the dead are
- Dead people are placed in GRAVES
- The equivalent of Sheol

Matthew 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

 Geena fires didn't burn continually. Therefore, the everlasting fire mentioned in Matthew 18: 8 is everlasting in its effects. The wicked will be burned up never to exist again.

Malachi 4:1-3 For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith the LORD of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch. The identification of the ten horns of Daniel 7 is firmly established in history. When we look at the historical record, the Alemanni, Anglo-Saxons, Franks, Burgundians, Visigoths, Suevi, Ostrogoths, Heruli, Lombards and the Vandals are ten tribal kingdoms which existed during the time of the Roman Empire.

If, as the Reformers contended, the little horn represented the Papacy, then history must testify to this fact. In 538 the emperor of the Eastern Roman Empire, Justinian, bestowed the title of Universal Bishop upon Pope Vigilius. The popes, by an act of self-appropriation, had long before taken the religio-political title of Pontifex Maximus after Emperor Gratian ceased to use that imperial title in 375. History must also testify to the identity of the three horns (kingdoms) that would be uprooted at the time of the rise of the papal power.

The Ostrogoths, Vandals and Heruli have vanished from Europe, leaving no trace in the twenty-first century. These three kingdoms were totally uprooted and destroyed by the Papal power exercising her authority over nations to carry out her dirty work.





These precepts are the basis of God's covenant with His people and the standard in God's judgment. Through the agency of the Holy Spirit they point out sin and awaken a sense of need for a Saviour. Salvation is all of grace and not of works andts fruit is obedience to the Commandments. This obedience develops Christian character and results in a sense of well-being. It is evidence of our love for the Lord and our concern for our fellow human beings. The obedience of faith demonstrates the power of Christ to transform lives, and therefore strengthens Christian witness. (Exod. 20:17; Deut. 28:1 -14; Ps. 19:7 -14; 40:7, 8; Matt. 5:17 -20; 22:36 -40; John 14:15; 15:7 -10; Rom. 8:3, 4; Eph. 2:8 -10; Heb. 8:8 -10; I John 2:3; 5:3; Rev. 12:17; 14:12 .)

They Keep the Faith of Jesus Christ: Justification by Faith

<u>Psalm 5:4</u> For thou art not a God that hath pleasure in wickedness: neither shall evil dwell with thee.

 $\underline{1 \text{ John 1:9}}$ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Romans 5:1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

<u>Hebrews 9:13-14</u> For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, **purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?**

1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

In much of the service professedly done for God, there is self-emulation and self-exaltation. God hates pretense. When men and women receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit, they will confess their sins, and pardon—which means justification—will be given them; but the wisdom of human agents who are not penitent, not humbled, is not to be depended on; for they are blinded in regard to the meaning of righteousness and sanctification through the truth. When men are stripped of self-righteousness, they will see their spiritual poverty... {Lt173-1902.13}

Here the truth is laid out in plain lines. This mercy and goodness is wholly undeserved. The grace of Christ is freely to justify the sinner without merit or claim on his part. **Justification** is a full, complete pardon of sin. The moment a sinner accepts Christ by faith, that moment he is pardoned. The righteousness of Christ is imputed to him, and he is no more to doubt God's forgiving grace. {RC 78.3}

Justification means that the conscience, purged from dead works, is placed where it can receive the blessings of sanctification. {Ms113-1902.26}

Romans 4:5-8 But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom **God imputeth righteousness without works, Saying, Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered.** Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin.

The conditions of eternal life, under grace, are just what they were in Eden—perfect righteousness, harmony with God, perfect conformity to the principles of His law. <u>1 Thessalonians 5:19-21</u> Quench not the Spirit. **Despise not prophesyings. Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.**


