1 CORINTHIANS 3:17 IF ANY MAN DEFILE THE TEMPLE OF GOD, HIM SHALL GOD DESTROY; FOR THE TEMPLE OF GOD IS HOLY, WHICH TEMPLE YE ARE.

ROMANS 6:23 FOR THE WAGES OF SIN IS
DEATH; BUT THE GIFT OF GOD IS ETERNAL LIFE

Closely aligned with God's moral law is
His natural law. They are the laws
governing our health - health laws.
God's commands are exceeding broad.
(Psalm 119:96) When King David
committed adultery, he afterward
complained of being deprived of his
health (Psalms 51:1,8). In breaking God's
moral law, he found that he sinned
against his own body. (1 Corinthians
6:18)

We must study how to take care of our bodies because God holds us responsible for how we treat them.

WHO WROTE THE TEN COMMANDMENTS?

Exodus 31:18 And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of God.

Exodus 32:16 And the tables were the work of God, and the writing was the writing of God, graven upon the tables.

Answer: In the book of Exodus,
Moses went up to commune with
God on Mount Sinai. While Moses
was on Mount Sinai, God wrote with
His own finger, on two tables of
stone, the Ten Commandments. The
commandments of God can be
termed the law of God.

WHAT IS THE TERM WE USE TO DESCRIBE THE BREAKING OF THE COMMANDMENTS?

1 John 3:4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.

Answer: When we break God's law, it is called sin because sin is the transgression of God's law.

NEW TESTAMENT

Some people argue that God's law has been done away with. This argument is not supported in the Scripture. Jesus and Paul emphasized the importance of God's law by quoting the commandments multiple times. God's moral laws are found in the New Testament.

AT THE CROSS

WHAT WAS DONE AWAY WITH AT THE CROSS?

Jeremiah 31:35-36 Thus saith the LORD, which giveth the sun for a light by day, and the ordinances of the moon and of the stars for a light by night, which divideth the sea when the waves thereof roar; The LORD of hosts is his name: If those ordinances depart from before me, saith the LORD, then the seed of Israel also shall cease from being a nation before me for ever.

Hebrews 10:1 For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.

Colossians 2:14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

John 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

Answer: Moses wrote down ordinances called the ceremonial law. Those laws, such as the slaughter of animals for sacrifice, pointed to the Lamb of God. Jesus fulfilled those laws at His death. At that time, literal Israel ceased to be God's special nation.
