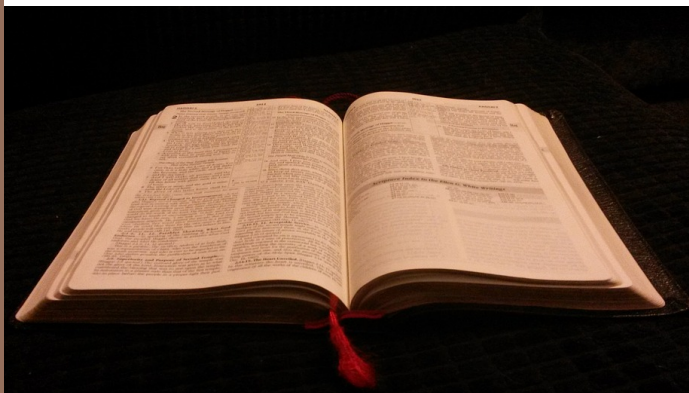

BY EVERY WORD

Matthew 4:4 But he answered and said, **It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.**

Matthew 5:18 **For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.**

Jesus Christ taught that His followers should live by every word of God. Moreover, Christ taught that not one jot or tittle would become insignificant. Every word and all punctuation in the Bible is significant and timeless. When the wicked attempt to change God's message given through Scripture, the Lord will hold them accountable and punish them accordingly. (Revelation 22:18-19)

Matthew 18:11 (KJV) "For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost."

The modern versions either omit, place in the foot notes, question their authenticity, or place in brackets, Mark 16:9-20 and John 7:53-8:11

Daniel 3:25 (KJV) "Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God".

RV "and the aspect of the fourth is like a son of the gods".

RSV "and the appearance of the fourth is like a son of the gods".

JB and NIV "and the fourth looks like a son of the gods".

The translators of the English King James version reflect the early Christian view that the fourth person was the second person of the Godhead. In doing so, they are acknowledging Christ's preexistence. The above four versions which fail to make this point ignore the context where Nebuchadnezzar acknowledged the superiority of Israel's God (Daniel 3:26-29; 4:2). They are in line with Origenism.
